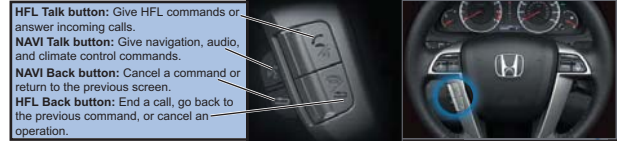

Position Setup	3	<p>Driving Position Memory System (DPMS) <i>If equipped</i></p> <p>Note: In order for the vehicle to associate the personalized settings with the correct driver, the customer (before entering the vehicle) must first unlock the vehicle with his or her remote transmitter.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Position the driver's seat to the primary driver's preference. Confirm that the primary driver will use remote transmitter 1. Program remote transmitter 1 to the DPMS. If a secondary driver is present, offer to program remote transmitter 2 to his or her seat preference.

Address: _____ Show the customer the Navi Talk/Back buttons and their functions. Show the customer where to find the Commonly Used Navigation Voice Commands in the Technology Reference Guide. <p>NOTE: The voice command system can only be used from the driver's position. Radio Presets Store up to 6 AM radio stations, and 12 FM stations (FM1 and FM2 [6 stations each])
 For vehicles with XM® Radio, 12 channels can be stored in the preset (1-6) buttons (XM1 and XM2 [6 channels each]).
NOTE: XM Radio will not operate in Alaska, Puerto Rico, or Hawaii.

- To store a station:
1. Use the tune, seek, or scan function to tune to a desired station or channel.
 2. Pick a preset number button (1-6).
 3. Press and hold it until you hear a beep.
