The Honda Civic is equipped with a number of convenience features that can be customized to your customer's preferences (applicable features depend on the vehicle's trim level). Personalize the settings for your customer as listed below. Additional details are contained in the Technology Reference Guide, Owner's Manual, and Navigation System Manual.

INTELLIGENT MULTI-INFORMATION DISPLAY (i-MID) CUSTOMIZATION
Except DX models

- Show the customer how to change one of the i-MID personalized settings.
- Confirm that the customer can change a setting in the i-MID while you watch.

AUTO DOOR LOCK *Select when the doors automatically lock.*

SHIFT FROM "P" All doors lock when the shift lever is moved out of Park (P).

WITH VEHICLE SPEED **ALL DOORS LOCK WHEN THE VEHICLE SPEED REACHES ABOUT 10 MPH.**

OFF Auto door lock function is deactivated.

AUTO DOOR UNLOCK *Select when the doors automatically unlock.*

SHIFT TO "P" DRIVER DOOR **DRIVER'S DOOR UNLOCKS WHEN THE SHIFT LEVER IS MOVED TO PARK (P).** (Default for A/T only)

SHIFT TO "P" ALL DOORS All doors unlock when the shift lever is moved to Park (P).

IGN OFF DRIVER DOOR **DRIVER'S DOOR UNLOCKS WHEN IGNITION SWITCH IS TURNED OFF.** (Default for M/T only)

IGN OFF ALL DOORS All doors unlock when the ignition switch is turned off.

OFF/DEACTIVATED Auto door unlock function is deactivated.

DOOR LOCK MODE *Changes which doors unlock when the remote transmitter is pressed once.*

DRIVER'S DOOR **DRIVER'S DOOR UNLOCKS WHEN THE REMOTE TRANSMITTER IS PRESSED ONCE.**

ALL DOORS All doors unlock when the remote transmitter is pressed once.

INTERIOR LIGHT DIMMING TIME *Select how long the vehicle's interior lights remain on after closing the doors.*

SECURITY RELOCK TIMER *Select how long it takes for the doors to relock and the security system to set after you unlock but do not open the door.*

Bluetooth® HandsFreeLink® (HFL)
Except DX and LX models

- Set the phone to Discovery Mode / Auto Recognize HFL.
- Pair the customer's phone.
- Confirm phone pairing**
 - Turn off the phone and the vehicle.
 - Turn on the phone and restart the vehicle.
- Show the customer the HFL buttons and their functions.
- Confirm that the customer can successfully place and receive calls.
- Demonstrate to the customer the Top Commonly Used HFL Voice Commands.

Top Commonly Used HFL Voice Commands:

- "Call/Dial <phone number>" (Navi models: from Map screen)
- "Call/Dial <name>" (Navi models: from Map screen)
- "HandsFree Help"
- "Phone Setup"
- "Phonebook"

Non-Navi Models:

Pick-Up button: Answer an incoming call, or go directly to the Phone screen.

Hang-Up/Back button: End a call, decline an incoming call, or cancel a section.

Talk button: Make a call using a stored voice tag.

Navi Models:

Pick-Up button: Answer an incoming call, or go directly to the Phone screen.

Hang-Up/Back button: End a call, decline an incoming call, or cancel a section.

Talk button: Give navigation, HFL, or audio commands.

Top Commonly Used Navi Voice Commands:

1. "Find Nearest <point of interest>"
Example: "Find Nearest Bank"
2. (In Menu screen, under Address)
"<city, street name, address number>"
Example: "Torrance"/ "Main" / "1-9-1-9"
3. "Radio <frequency, band>"
Example: "Radio 97.1 FM"

NOTE: The voice control system can be used only from the driver's position. The microphone ignores talking and other noise from elsewhere in the vehicle.

Radio Presets Use the preset buttons to store and recall up to 12 FM stations (6 stations each on FM1 and FM2) and 6 AM stations. For vehicles with XM® Radio, 12 XM channels can also be stored (6 channels each on XM1 and XM2).

NOTE: XM Radio will not operate in Alaska, Puerto Rico, or Hawaii.

To store a station:

1. Use the tune, seek, or scan function to tune to a desired station or channel.
2. Choose a preset button (1-6).
3. Press and hold the button until you hear a beep.
