



2012 Honda Fit Personalized Settings

The Honda Fit is equipped with a number of convenience features that can be customized to your customer's preferences (applicable features depend on the vehicle's trim level). Personalize the settings for your customer as listed below. Additional details are in the Technology Reference Guide, Owner's Manual, and Navigation Manual.

Note: The default factory settings appear in **bold**.

1 **Auto Door Lock** *Select when the doors automatically lock.*

SHIFT FROM "P" All doors lock when the shift lever is moved out of Park (P).

WITH VEHICLE SPEED **ALL DOORS LOCK WHEN THE VEHICLE SPEED REACHES ABOUT 10 MPH.**

OFF Auto door lock function is deactivated.

2 **Auto Door Unlock** *Select when the doors automatically unlock.*

SHIFT TO "P" DRIVER DOOR **DRIVER'S DOOR UNLOCKS WHEN THE SHIFT LEVER IS MOVED TO PARK (P) (default for A/T only).**

SHIFT TO "P" ALL DOORS All doors unlock when the shift lever is moved to Park (P).

IGN OFF DRIVER DOOR **DRIVER'S DOOR UNLOCKS WHEN THE IGNITION SWITCH IS TURNED OFF (default for M/T only).**

IGN OFF ALL DOORS All doors unlock when the ignition switch is turned off.

OFF/DEACTIVATED Auto door unlock function is deactivated.

3 **HANDS-FREE RECOGNITION SYSTEMS (Bluetooth® HandsFreeLink® and Voice Command System)**
To confirm that the customer's cell phone is compatible and to view/confirm phone pairing information, go to handsfreelink.honda.com or call **Bluetooth® HFL** customer support at (888) 528-7876.

Bluetooth® HandsFreeLink® (HFL)

1. Set the phone to Discovery Mode / Auto Recognize HFL.

2. Pair the customer's phone.

Confirm phone pairing

- Turn off the phone and the vehicle.
- Turn on the phone and restart the vehicle.

Show the customer the HFL buttons and their functions.

Confirm that the customer can successfully place and receive calls.

Demonstrate to the customer the Top Commonly Used HFL Voice Commands.

HFL Auto Transfer function

Demonstrate the voice tag system.

Pick-up button: Answer an incoming call, or go directly to the Phone screen.

Talk button: Give navigation, HFL, or audio commands.

Back button: Cancel a command and return to the previous screen.

Hang-Up: End a call or decline a call.

Top Commonly Used HFL Voice Commands:

1. "Dial by voice tag" (from any screen)
2. "Dial by number" (from any screen)
3. "Phonebook" (from Phone screen)
4. "Phone Setup" (from Phone screen)
5. "Help" (from any screen)

4 **NAVIGATION SYSTEM (If equipped)**

1. Set up the "Go Home" feature.

2. Show the customer the Talk/Back buttons and their functions.

3. Show the customer where to find the Commonly Used Voice Commands in the Technology Reference Guide.

NOTE: The voice control system can only be used from the driver's position. The microphone ignores talking and other noise from elsewhere in the vehicle.

Top Commonly Used Navi Voice Commands:

1. "Find Nearest (desired POI)" Example: "Find Nearest Bank"
2. In 'Address' of Menu screen, system will prompt user to say "(desired City name/desired Street Name/ desired #)" Example: "Torrance"/"Main"/"1919"
3. "Radio (desired #) FM" Example: "Radio 97.1 FM"

5 **Radio Presets** *Store up to 6 AM radio stations, and 12 FM stations (FM1 and FM2 [6 stations each])*

To store a station:

1. Use the tune, seek, or scan function to tune to a desired station or channel.
2. Pick a preset number button (1-6).
3. Press and hold it until you hear a beep.
