The Honda Odyssey is equipped with a number of convenience features that can be customized to your customer's preferences (applicable features depend on the vehicle's trim level). Personalize the settings for your customer as listed below. Additional details are contained in the Technology Reference Guide, Owner's Manual, and Navigation Manual.

MULTI-INFORMATION DISPLAY (MID) CUSTOMIZATION

Available on Touring models

1. Refer to the Multi-Information Display (MID) section in the Technology Reference Guide.
2. Show the customer how to change one of the MID personalized settings.
3. Confirm that the customer can change a setting in the MID while you watch.

AUTO DOOR LOCK (For vehicles equipped with MID, this is in the DOOR SETUP Group)

Select when the doors automatically lock.

- SHIFT FROM "P" All doors lock when the shift lever is moved out of Park (P).
- WITH VEHICLE SPEED** **ALL DOORS LOCK WHEN THE VEHICLE SPEED REACHES ABOUT 10 MPH.**
- OFF Auto door lock function is deactivated.

AUTO DOOR UNLOCK (For vehicles equipped with MID, this is in the DOOR SETUP Group)

Select when the doors automatically unlock.

- SHIFT TO "P" DRIVER DOOR** **DRIVER'S DOOR UNLOCKS WHEN THE SHIFT LEVER IS MOVED TO PARK (P).**
- SHIFT TO "P" ALL DOORS All doors unlock when the shift lever is moved to Park (P).
- IGN OFF DRIVER DOOR Driver's door unlocks when the ignition switch is turned off.
- IGN OFF ALL DOORS All doors unlock when the ignition switch is turned off.
- OFF/DEACTIVATED Auto door unlock function is deactivated.

KEY AND REMOTE UNLOCK MODE

Select which doors unlock when you press the unlock button on the remote transmitter once, or when you unlock the driver's door using the key.

NOTE: For Touring models, this setting is changed in the MID.

- DRIVER'S DOOR** ALL DOORS

POWER TAILGATE Select when the power tailgate can be opened using the remote transmitter.

Available on EX-L / Touring models.

NOTE: For Touring models, this setting is changed in the MID.

- ANYTIME** **THE POWER TAILGATE UNLOCKS AND OPENS WHEN YOU PRESS AND HOLD THE POWER TAILGATE BUTTON FOR ONE SECOND.**
- WHEN UNLOCKED The power tailgate must already be unlocked before you can open it with the remote transmitter.

POWER SLIDING DOORS Select when either power sliding door can be opened using the remote transmitter.

Available on all models except LX.

NOTE: For Touring models, this setting is changed in the MID.

- ANYTIME** **THE POWER SLIDING DOOR UNLOCKS AND OPENS WHEN YOU PRESS AND HOLD THE RESPECTIVE BUTTON FOR ONE SECOND.**
- WHEN UNLOCKED The power sliding door must already be unlocked before you can open it with the remote transmitter.

Available on Odyssey vehicles equipped with Bluetooth® HandsFreeLink®

Bluetooth® HandsFreeLink® (HFL)

1. Set the phone to Discovery Mode / Auto Recognize HFL.
2. Pair the customer's phone.
- Confirm phone pairing**
- Turn off the phone and the vehicle.
 - Turn on the phone and restart the vehicle.

- Show the customer the HFL buttons and their functions.

Available on EX-L Navi and Touring Models:

- From any screen besides the Phone screen, the customer can press the

Talk button and use the "Dial by number" or "Dial by voice tag" commands

- Confirm that the customer can successfully place and receive calls.
- Demonstrate to the customer the Top Commonly Used HFL Voice Commands.

Position the driver's seat and outside mirrors to the primary driver's preferences. 2. Confirm that the primary driver will use remote transmitter 1. 3. Program remote transmitter 1 to the DPMS. 4.
