Multi-Information Display (MID)	MID	<p><b>MULTI-INFORMATION DISPLAY (MID) CUSTOMIZATION</b> <i>Available on Touring models.</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Refer to the Multi-Information Display (MID) section in the Technology Reference Guide.</li> <li>Show the customer how to change one of the MID personalized settings.</li> <li>Confirm that the customer can change a setting in the MID while you watch.</li> </ol>
	1	<p><b>AUTO DOOR LOCK</b> (In the DOOR / WINDOW SETUP Group) <i>Select when the doors automatically lock.</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> SHIFT FROM "P" All doors lock when the shift lever is moved out of Park (P).</p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> <b>WITH VEHICLE SPEED</b> <b>ALL DOORS LOCK WHEN THE VEHICLE SPEED REACHES ABOUT 10 MPH.</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> OFF Auto door lock function is deactivated.</p>
	2	<p><b>AUTO DOOR UNLOCK</b> (In the DOOR / WINDOW SETUP Group) <i>Select when the doors automatically unlock.</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> SHIFT TO "P" <b>UNLOCKS WHEN THE SHIFT LEVER IS MOVED TO PARK (P).</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> IGN OFF Unlocks when the ignition switch is turned off.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> OFF/DEACTIVATED Auto door unlock function is deactivated.</p> <p><i>Select which doors automatically unlock.</i></p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> <b>DRIVER DOOR</b> <b>DRIVER'S DOOR UNLOCKS.</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> ALL DOORS All doors unlock.</p>
	3	<p><b>POWER TAILGATE</b> <i>Select when the power tailgate can be opened using the remote transmitter.</i> <i>Available on Touring models.</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> ANYTIME <b>THE POWER TAILGATE UNLOCKS AND OPENS WHEN YOU PRESS AND HOLD THE POWER TAILGATE BUTTON FOR ONE SECOND.</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> WHEN UNLOCKED The power tailgate must already be unlocked before you can open it with the remote transmitter.</p>
	4	<p><b>KEY AND REMOTE UNLOCK MODE</b> <i>Changes which doors unlock when the remote transmitter is pressed once.</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> DRIVER'S DOOR <b>DRIVER'S DOOR UNLOCKS WHEN THE REMOTE TRANSMITTER IS PRESSED ONCE.</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> ALL DOORS All doors unlock when the remote transmitter is pressed once.</p>
	5	<p><b>INTERIOR LIGHT DIMMING TIME</b> <i>Select how long the vehicle's interior lights remain on after closing the doors.</i></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 15 SECONDS <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> <b>30 SECONDS</b> <input type="checkbox"/> 60 SECONDS</p>
6	<p><b>SECURITY RELOCK TIMER</b> <i>Select how long it takes for the doors to relock and the security system to set after you unlock but do not open the door.</i></p> <p><input checked="" type="checkbox"/> <b>30 SECONDS</b> <input type="checkbox"/> 60 SECONDS <input type="checkbox"/> 90 SECONDS</p>	
Position Setup	7	<p><b>DRIVING POSITION MEMORY SYSTEM (DPMS)</b> <b>Note: In order for the vehicle to associate the personalized settings with the correct driver, the customer (before entering the vehicle) must first unlock the vehicle with his or her remote transmitter.</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> ON <b>DPMS IS ON/ACTIVE</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> OFF DPMS is off/deactivated</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Position the driver's seat and outside mirrors to the primary driver's preferences.</li> <li>Confirm that the primary driver will use remote transmitter 1.</li> <li>Program remote transmitter 1 to the DPMS.</li> <li>If a secondary driver is present, offer to program remote transmitter 2 to his or her seat and mirror position preferences.</li> </ol>
Navigation	8	<p><b>NAVIGATION SYSTEM (If equipped)</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 1. Set up the "Go Home" feature. Address: _____</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 2. Show the customer the Talk/Back buttons and their functions.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> 3. Show the customer where to find the Commonly Used Navigation Voice Commands in the Technology Reference Guide.</p> <p><b>NOTE: The voice command system can only be used from the driver's position. The microphone ignores talking and other noise from elsewhere in the vehicle.</b></p> <div style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin-top: 10px;"> <p><b>Top Commonly Used Navigation Voice Commands:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>"Find Nearest (desired POI)" Example: <b>"Find Nearest Bank"</b></li> <li>In Menu screen, under "Address", system will prompt user to say "(desired City name/desired Street Name/ desired address)" Example: <b>"Torrance"/"Main"/"1919"</b></li> <li>"Temperature (desired #) degrees" Example: <b>"Temperature 70 degrees"</b></li> <li>"Fan Speed (desired #)" Example: <b>"Fan Speed 2"</b></li> <li>"Radio (desired #) FM" Example: <b>"Radio 97.1 FM"</b></li> </ol> </div>
