DOOR SETUP	1	<p>Auto Door Lock</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> WITH VEHICLE SPEED Doors lock when vehicle speed reaches about 9 mph.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> SHIFT FROM "P" Doors lock when the shift lever is moved out of Park (P).</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;"><i>To activate:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Apply the parking brake. (2) Move the shift lever to P and close the driver's door. (3) Turn the ignition switch to the ON (II) position. (4) Push and hold the front of the master door lock switch on the driver's door. You will hear a click. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Keep holding the switch until you hear another click (after about 5 seconds). (5) Release the switch and turn the ignition switch to the LOCK (0) position within 5 seconds. <p><input type="checkbox"/> OFF Auto door lock function is deactivated.</p> <p>Consult the Technology Reference Guide and/or Owner's Manual for instructions on how to change the feature settings.</p>	
	2	<p>Auto Door Unlock</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> SHIFT TO "P" DRIVER DOOR Driver's door unlocks when the shift lever is moved into Park (P) with the brake pedal depressed.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> SHIFT TO "P" ALL DOORS All doors unlock when the shift lever is moved into Park (P) with the brake pedal depressed.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;"><i>To activate:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Apply the parking brake. (2) Move the shift lever to P, and close the driver's door. (3) Turn the ignition switch to the ON (II) position. (4) Push and hold the rear of the master door lock switch on the driver's door. You will hear a click. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Continue holding until you hear two or more clicks (after about 10 seconds) to activate all doors unlock. (5) Release the switch and turn the ignition switch to the LOCK (0) position within 5 seconds. <p><input type="checkbox"/> IGNITION OFF DRIVER DOOR Driver's door unlocks when ignition switch is turned to ACCESSORY (I) position.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> IGNITION OFF ALL DOORS All doors unlock when ignition switch is turned to ACCESSORY (I) position.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> OFF/DEACTIVATED Auto door unlock function is deactivated.</p> <p>Consult the Technology Reference Guide and/or Owner's Manual for instructions on how to change the feature settings.</p>	
Bluetooth® HandsFreeLink®	3	<p>Bluetooth® HandsFreeLink® (HFL) For Ridgeline vehicles equipped with Bluetooth® HandsFreeLink®</p> <p>Note: To use HFL, the phone must have approved Bluetooth capability.</p> <p>To confirm that the customer's cell phone is compatible with HFL and to view/confirm phone pairing information:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Go to handsfreelink.honda.com, or call the HFL customer support line at (888) 528-7876. (2) Then: Review Bluetooth® phones that work best with HFL. (3) Confirm the customer's cell phone will function with HFL. (4) Turn the ignition switch on and use the interface dial to select "OK" on the navigation screen. (5) Make sure the phone is in "discover" or "search" mode, then set up the cell phone to prepare for Bluetooth® connection. <p>If neither you nor the customer can successfully place the phone into "discover" or "search" mode, and the customer still requires setup assistance, request that the customer bring a copy of his/her cell phone owner's manual to the dealership for assistance.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (6) Pair the customer's phone. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Get pairing instructions from handsfreelink.honda.com - Go to the vehicle and pair the phone according to the instructions. <p>Note: It is important to remember that you must press and release the HFL Talk Button on the steering wheel and wait for the beep before you speak. This step is required before all spoken commands.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (7) Reconfirm phone linkage: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Turn off the phone. - Turn off the engine. - Turn the phone on again. - Restart the vehicle. (8) After the phone is successfully paired, review the AUTO TRANSFER function with the customer. Confirm if the customer would like the function: <p><input type="checkbox"/> ON (activated) <input type="checkbox"/> OFF (deactivated)</p> <p>USAGE</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (1) Show the customer the location of the HFL TALK button on the steering wheel. (2) Show the customer the location of the HFL BACK button on the steering wheel. (3) Confirm that the customer can successfully place a test call. <p>NOTE: The command must be given with "Call" or "Dial," followed by the telephone number.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (4) To ensure the customer has a good experience with the HFL system, advise the customer to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (A) Avoid select text: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - "Home" - Single syllable name entries (B) Use multi-syllabic name entries <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pete → Peter (C) Encourage to use "System Help" when confused (D) Do not raise voice or yell when frustrated – it decreases system recognition (5) Demonstrate to the customer the Top Commonly Used HFL Voice Commands (6) Confirm that the customer can successfully receive a test call (7) Demonstrate the Voice Tag system (8) Make sure to complete follow-up call to customer once customer has immediately left dealership. 	

Top Commonly Used HFL Voice Commands:

1. "Call/Dial <phone number>"
2. "Call/Dial <name>" (when voice tags are stored)
3. "HandsFree Help"
4. "Phone Setup"
5. "Phonebook"

NAVIGATION SYSTEM
Set address for "go home" voice recognition command and GO HOME selection in the navigation system.

HOME ADDRESS SETUP
(1) Push the SETUP button on the navigation system.
(2) Select PERSONAL INFORMATION.
(3) Select HOME ADDRESS.
(4) Specify User 1 or User 2.
(5) Enter the customer's home address.

USAGE
(1) Demonstrate the "Go Home" feature.
When Demonstrating the "Go Home" feature, be sure to advise the customer of the optional routing methods available. If the customer's address is not in the system, be sure to explain that the area MAY be included in the next update for the following year.
(2) Show the customer the difference between the Navi and the HFL Speech Recognition buttons.
(3) Show the customer how to correctly use the speech recognition buttons and voice commands.
(4) Show the customer the location of the microphone on the ceiling (speak in a normal voice).
(5) Demonstrate to the customer the Top Commonly Used Navi Voice Commands.
(6) Show the customer the Commonly Used Voice Commands in the **Technology Reference Guide.**

Top Commonly Used Navi Voice Commands:

1. "Find Nearest (desired POI)" Example: **"Find Nearest Bank"**
2. In 'Address' of Menu screen system will prompt user to say "(desired City Name/desired Street Name/desired House#)"
Example: **"Torrance"/"Main"/"1919"**
3. "Temperature (desired #) degrees"
Example: **"Temperature 70 degrees"**
4. "Fan Speed (desired #)" Example: **"Fan Speed 2"**
5. "XM Channel (desired #)" Example: **"XM Channel 20"**

AUDIO

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Radio Presets Store up to 6 AM radio stations, 12 FM stations [FM1 & FM2 (6 stations each)].
And for vehicles with XM® Radio, 12 channels can be stored in the preset (1-6) buttons [XM1 & XM2 (6 channels each)].

To store a station:
(1) Use the tune, seek, or scan function to tune the radio to a desired station.
(2) Pick a preset number button (1-6).
(3) Push and hold it until you hear a beep.
